To help clarify any confusing words or phrases you may come across, we have put together a Jargon Buster for families following the 2014 National Curriculum in England curriculum.

Here are some key terms and acronyms that you may encounter:

- Academy: A state-funded school independent of local authority control, operated as a self-governing non-profit charitable trust.
- AfL (Assessment for Learning): The process of seeking and interpreting evidence for use by learners and teachers to track progress and plan next steps in learning.
- **ASC (ASD)**: Autism Spectrum Condition, sometimes referred to as ASD (Autistic Spectrum Disorder).
- **Blending**: Drawing individual sounds together to pronounce a word.
- **CIc**: Children in Care.
- CLA: Children Looked After.
- **CPD**: Continuing Professional Development.
- **CPOMS**: Child Protection Online Management System.
- **CSS**: Children's Support Service (formerly known as Pupil Referral Unit).
- **CSW**: Child Support Worker.
- DBS (Disclosure & Barring Service): The agency responsible for safeguarding checks.
- **DfE**: Department for Education.
- **DSL**: Designated Safeguarding Lead.
- **EAL**: English as an Additional Language.
- EBD: Emotional and Behavioural Difficulties.
- EHC Plan: Educational Health Care Plan.
- **EMTAS**: Ethnic Minority & Traveller Achievement Service.
- **EWO**: Education Welfare Officer.

- EYFS: Early Years Foundation Stage.
- FSM: Free School Meals.

- GCSE: General Certificate of Secondary Education.
- **HI**: Hearing Impairment.
- **HLTA**: Higher Level Teaching Assistant.
- **HMI**: Her Majesty's Inspector of Schools.
- Inclusion: Removing barriers in learning for all pupils.
- INSET: In-Service Education and Training.
- KS (Key Stage): Stages of the national curriculum.
- **LA**: Local Authority.
- LAC: Looked After Children.
- MLD: Moderate Learning Difficulties.
- M&H: Moving and Handling.
- NC: National Curriculum.
- Ofsted: Office for Standards in Education.
- **PE**: Physical Education.
- **Phonics**: Method for teaching English reading and writing.
